1. JUMPING

Type of ground:	Sand
Arena size	65 x 45m (FEI Jumping World Challenge)

IV. COMPETITIONS

Horses which enter any of the FEI Jumping World Challenge are not allowed to start in HKEF Local Jumping Competition No. 4 - No. 7 and vice versa.

In case an athlete is riding more than one horse, the declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds.

There will be an INDIVIDUAL ranking per Country, per Region and for the World for all 3 Categories. In order to be in the rankings, an Athlete/Horse combination must compete in a minimum of two Competitions and in any case not more than three Competitions per Category. Only the results of the best TWO Competitions per Category will count for the rankings. An athlete can only be in the rankings per Category once with the Horse Declared before the 1st Competition.

V. PRIZE AND PRIZE GIVINGS

- Best Presentation Award will be selected by the Judges and the Veterinarians during the Horse Inspection.
- Rosettes will be awarded to the best 25% and Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 placed riders as described under each competition. However, no prize money will be offered if there is only 1 rider.
- There will be a mounted prize giving for Jumping Competitors immediately following the Cat C (Round 2), Cat B (Round 2), Cat A (Round 2) on 7 Mar 2020 (Sat).

VI. PARTICIPATION

Number of entries	Minimum 1 per class
Number of horses per rider	Maximum 2 per class

- A horse may compete with only ONE athlete, in only ONE Category throughout the FEI Jumping World Challenge during the same year.
- Horses cannot be ridden by more than one athlete in one Category throughout the FEI Jumping World Challenge during the same year.
- Athletes may ride more than one horse in a category but the results of only one horse will count. This horse must be declared before the first round of the first Competition in which the athlete takes part. The athlete must complete the official FEI Declaration Form, sign it and submit it to the HKEF. The declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds of all Competitions. The results obtained with the other horses will not count towards the final standings.
- Any rider that has competed in the Youth Olympic Games is eligible to compete in the FEI Jumping World Challenge

VII. ENTRIES

Closing Date for entries:

Entry Cancellation – Entries cancelled after closing time must be verified with a Veterinary Certificate or Medical Certificate, otherwise Entry fee will not be refund by the OC.

VIII. OTHER REGULATIONS

1. Liabilities

All athletes will participate in the Event at their own risk. By participating the athlete acknowledges that in case of any accident during the Event or at a training session held associated with the Event they disclaim any civil rights arising under any enactment against other athletes participating in the Event or the training session.

The OC/HKEF is not responsible for the following liabilities:

Any injuries, diseases, and accidents to the horses, athletes and officials during the time of transportation or during the competition period.

Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating athletes and horses during the time of transportation or during the competition period.

2. EVENT'S ORGANISATION (HKEF Rules Art. 101)

The OC reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the President of HKEF (or his authorized representative). Modifications during the event may only be made by the Ground Jury.
