** Any member who wishes to compete in local ranking competitions of affiliated shows from 1st September to 31st August will be required to pay a Rider Registration Fee of HK.\$ 400 and a Horse Registration Fee of HK.\$400 for his or her competition horse before the start of the local ranking competition in which he or she has submitted entries to the OC. Affiliated shows refer to shows organized by the HKEF or other riding schools in accordance with HKEF Rules, or in the case of international competitions, under the Rules of the FEI.

X. HKEF DRESSAGE GRADING SYSTEM

Competitors should check their combination's eligible level before submitting entry to the competition. For the eligible level, please refer to the "*HKEF Dressage Horse-rider Combination Grading System*" (<https://www.hkef.org/eng/competitions/rules-n-regulations/rules-regulations.html>). If a combination enters into a class which is under their eligible level, no placing, prize and horse of the year points will be awarded.

XI. OTHER REGULATIONS
