All Athletes taking part in a Grand Prix at a CSI must also have completed, with their Grand Prix Horse, the training session scheduled on 26 April, 2019 (Friday) from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. after the horse inspection and technical meeting.

If an Athlete/Horse combination has completed the initial round of an FEI Competition prior to the Grand Prix, and the Athlete is subsequently eliminated or disqualified from the Competition in question, the Athlete may take part in the Grand Prix (if qualified), with the same Horse, as the Horse is deemed to have fulfilled the eligibility requirement of completing the initial round of an FEI Competition prior to the Grand Prix. Other details can be referred to the FEI approved schedule for the CSI1* Hong Kong on 27 April, 2019 (Saturday).

FEI Jumping Rules 2019 will be applied for this class.

The Show Organiser will provide first aid support to the show. However, Athletes, or their appointed guardian, are solely responsible to make decisions to remount and continue riding in the event of a fall. The Show Organiser recommend a doctor's opinion is sought before continuing to ride.

The Show Organiser is not responsible for the following liabilities:

Any decision of an Athlete to remount, and continue riding whether made by the Athlete himself / herself, or his / her parent, guardian, instructor or coach, and regardless of whether a doctor's opinion is sought after a fall.

3. EVENT'S ORGANISATION (HKEF Rules Art. 101)

The OC, with the permission of the President of Ground Jury, reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the President of HKEF (or his authorized representative).
